

## MWA Board Meeting 07-12-2011 – Minutes (By Nick D Pipinich – Secretary)

Meeting came to order at 9:15 p.m.

Steve & Gary – Talked about the donations of the Black Hawk stuff and the Top Gun 12 gauge 1oz #8 for 16 – 24 flats or 24 – 30 flats depending on what it ends up. We will have a couple of boxes for prizes from ATK for the MWA picnic

General Discussion on the MWA picnic. – Gary Delin will get the prizes from Wholesale Sports, and George will get the prizes from Yellowstone Gateway Sports. The club will donate \$500 total. We will split it into \$250 for each store, Yellowstone Gateway Sports and Wholesale Sports. We will look at \$250 - \$300 towards a raffle Gun. 0-15 Youths & 15-18 Split for each allotment. Old Farts will also be donating a .22 Cal rifle.

Gary Delin – Is going to ask Hank about Fogging for the Mosquitoes.

Steve Lovas – Researched an electronic Power Gate for the front entrance to the range. He spoke to David Corn. The gate is for two vertical Gates 16' swing gate & accessories plus 3000 individual keypad and rear keypad for an override to keep gate open. The cost is \$38,784.00 for the complete system, this is for the MWA doing nothing as far as help and or assistance. We could do labor and some concrete work. This is for not using Proximity cards, this is for keypad entry. The system tracks the number of who enters and exits the range and will be able to watch and records who is coming and going.

Paul Johnson – How do we pay the kids for the Trap help? Are they insured.. he has noticed there a lot of broken birds and half and three quarter broken boxes in the traps.

Gary Delin – They are current members and are being paid for helping load and set the traps.

Steve Lovas – If they have an accident setting up the Trap Loads, workman's Comp will be down on us (actual description omitted due to sensitivity).

Paul Johnson – Hard that we can't get shotgun shells for under \$5.00 a box. How do we plan out inventory and out purchasing.

Gary Delin – Is planning on purchasing several flats at a time so that he doesn't have to buy several times a year. He reviewed where we were currently on shells and what types and drams.

We needed to get a large amount of monies to get the Bulk order person to come out and deliver to our range without costing more money directly to us. We purchased 30 more flats to make up that money difference. He bought 40 cases at \$50.80 per flat of 1oz #8 so the MWA could have them because we were almost out of them here.

Steve Lovas – Do we have two or single signature checks? According to the By-Laws any checks in excess of \$500.00 needs to be signed both by the treasurer and president. This is by the accordance of the By-Laws. Do we comply or not? Is this something that we need to comply by?

Gary Delin – Brought up the incident at the range with the old farts and the other members.

Paul Johnson – Guys came in “four of them” and they were trying to shoot trap. They just took over, this was the impression that “Paul” had. They apparently dropped the Gary Delin name that he was in charge of the range could rule who does what.

Gary Delin – The deal was if they opened up the range for the range use it would be opened up for all members if they chose to also allowed to have other members join the Old Farts. The Old Farts apparently chose to close the time ONLY for the Old Farts exclusively and no one else. They told other people to leave the range until they were done and this was their time.

Paul Johnson – I can't walk into other folks shooting disciplines and just shoot next to them while they are trying to run a match or shoot.

Gary Delin – I didn't know it was a big deal to tell them “others” that they could come out & shoot with the Old Farts. They were told that they come out & wanted to shoot and waited until they were done & started to roll up the cords and then they were told that they weren't done and the fighting started with the Old Farts and the four “other” members.

George Chancellor – Called for the meeting to be adjourned.

Steve Lovas – Seconded this motion.
