

BY-LAWS OF THE  
MANHATTAN WILDLIFE ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I – Name

The name of this organization shall be THE MANHATTAN WILDLIFE ASSOCIATION. ~~The name of the shooting range located at Logan, Mt. shall be THE GALLATIN VALLEY SHOOTING COMPLEX.~~  
(Association has never been referred to or used the title of The Gallatin Valley Shooting Complex.  
Remove to reduce confusion)

ARTICLE III – Membership

Any citizen of the United States ~~18~~ 19 years of age or older, who is a member or who agrees to become a member of the National Rifle Association, may become a member of this organization providing they subscribe to the NRA pledge (below) and to the objectives of the organization as stated under ARTICLE II, and on payment of the usual membership fees and dues.  
(Change age to agree with age stated under Voting Rights)

Classes of Memberships: There shall be two classes of membership unless otherwise specifically provided for by the Board of Directors.

1) Annual Family membership: This membership shall entitle the member and their ~~his~~ immediate family to use the range facilities for the period June 1 thru May 31 of the following year. Immediate family is defined as spouse and children 18 yrs. of age or younger living at the same address.

2) ~~Individual~~ Life Memberships: Any eligible person, upon approval of the Board of Directors and payment of established cost ~~\$500.00~~, may become a life member. This entitles the member to the same privileges as defined in the annual membership to use the range facilities for life, with no further membership costs. Life membership expires when the primary member is deceased.  
(To further clarify and define individual and life membership and as to how the fee for life membership will be set by the Board of Directors rather than have it fixed in the By Laws. Life members may be asked in future to pay special assessments thus defined as no further membership costs.)

Voting Rights: Each membership shall be entitled to vote on the affairs of the Association only while in good standing. Each membership shall have one (1) vote ~~with a maximum of two (2) members voting per family membership.~~ Each voting member must ~~18 yrs. of age and be present.~~ No votes shall be allowed by proxy.  
(Change the membership is entitled to only one vote, this is a change which eliminates the multiple votes allowed under the current By Laws.)

ARTICLE IV

MEETINGS OF MEMBERS AND OFFICERS

Other Meetings: Special meetings of the membership may be called by the President or the Board of Directors, or by 5% of the memberships at a time and place designated by the President or Board of Directors. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by, or at the request of, the
